Estimated resident population

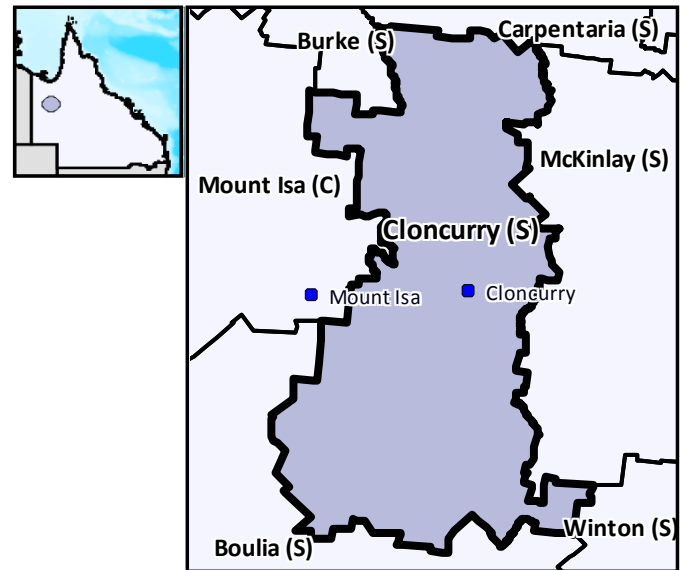
The preliminary estimated resident population of Cloncurry Shire Council at 30 June 2011 was 3,428 persons, an increase of 50 persons or 1.5 per cent over the year. This compares with a decrease of 2 persons or 0.1 per cent in the year to June 2010 (Table 1 and Figure 1).

Components of population change

In the year to June 2009, natural increase (births minus deaths) accounted for an increase of 39 persons while assumed net migration resulted in a loss of 65 persons (Table 1 and Figure 2).

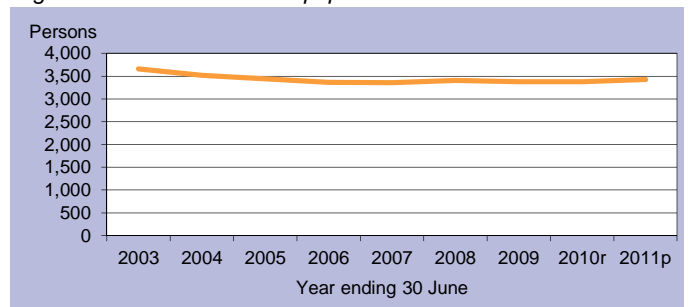
Population projections

Projections released in 2011 indicate that by 2016 the expected population of Cloncurry Shire Council will be between 3,543 and 3,886 persons (Table 2 and Figure 3). By 2031 this is expected to change to between 3,261 and 4,262 persons (low and high series).



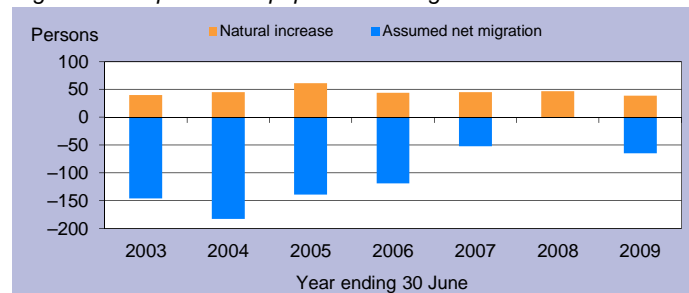
C = City S = Shire R = Regional Council T = Town

Figure 3: Population projections

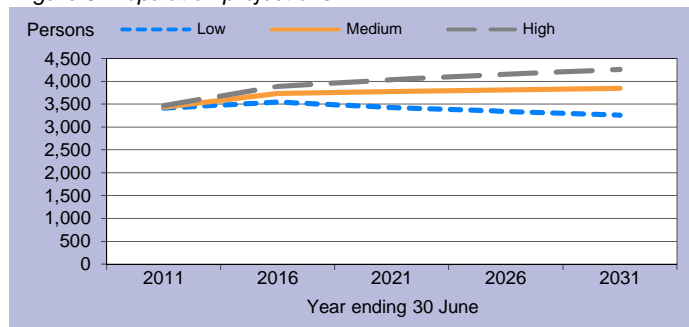

Age structure

The median age of Cloncurry Shire Council's population is projected to increase by 13.1 years from a median age of 29.9 years in 2006 to a median age of 43.0 years in 2031 (Table 3 and Figure 4). The median age of Queensland in 2031 is projected to be 40.2 years, under the medium series (Table 4).

Dwelling approvals

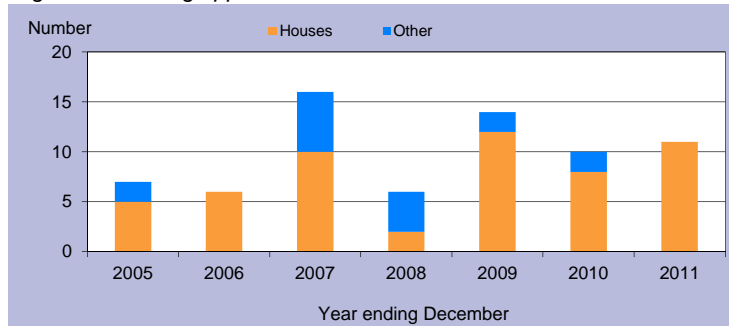
There were 11 new dwelling approvals in Cloncurry Shire Council over the year ending December 2011, an increase of 10.0 per cent from the previous year (10) (Table 5). Separate houses made up 100.0 per cent of all new dwelling approvals over the year ending December 2011 (Figure 5).

Figure 5: Dwelling approvals



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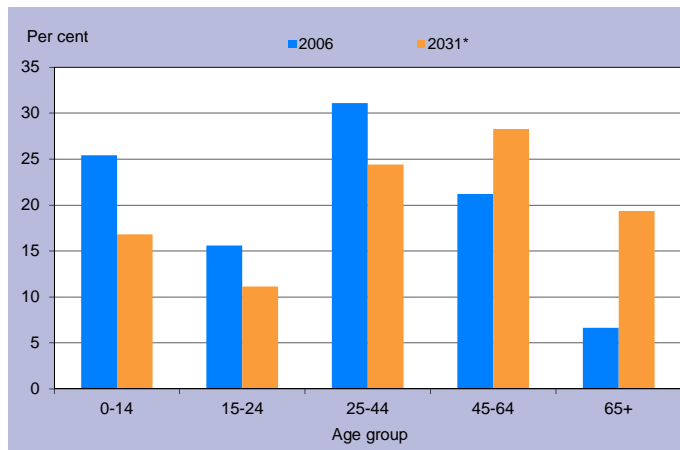

Household size

In 2006, the average household size for all occupied private dwellings in Cloncurry Shire Council was 2.7 persons. This compares with an average household size of 2.6 for all of Queensland in the same year (Table 6).
